

VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION ANIMAL CARE

TITLE:

Animal Care Assistant - Cats AC-C

MAJOR OBJECTIVE:

To provide cleaning assistance and enrichment to the cats kenneled in the adoption and lost and found kennels

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Clean & sanitize kennels to maintain the health & comfort of the animals
- 2. Provide enrichment such as toys and bedding to cats in available kennels
- 3. Assist kennel staff with miscellaneous kennel duties, as requested

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Ability and desire to handle and work with kenneled animals
- 2. Ability to lift up to 20 pounds, bend and stand for long periods
- 3. Willingness to maintain sanitation of animal areas
- 4. Ability to work independently
- 5. Good communication skills
- 6. Dedication to the philosophies of the pet adoption center
- 7. Minimum of 16 years of age

TRAINING:

- 1. Attend MSRPAC's volunteer general informational session
- 2. Interview with the Volunteer Services manager or designee.
- 3. Attend AC-C hands on training

TIME AND PLACE:

Shifts available every day during center's hours of operation.

COMMITMENT:

Three hours per week for a minimum of six months.

Direct supervision Director of Operations, indirect supervision by the Volunteer Services manager
