



VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION GENERAL OPERATIONS

TITLE:

Spay/Neuter Clinic Kennel Technician Assistant PS-SNCKTA

MAJOR OBJECTIVE:

To provide direct care to animals kenneled in clinic housing areas.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Clean kennels to maintain sanitation and health of the animals.
2. Assist surgical support staff with miscellaneous kennel duties, such as mopping, stocking supplies, feeding, laundry, cleaning surgical instruments, etc..

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Ability and desire to handle and work with animals.
2. Ability to view surgical procedures.
3. Initiative to work alone after being properly trained.
4. Dedication to the philosophies of the center.
5. Ability to follow disease protocols and clinic concepts.
6. Be able to lift up to 75 pounds.
7. Lifting and standing for long periods of time required.
8. Be able to bend and get up and down from the floor with ease.
9. Minimum age of 18 years.

TRAINING:

1. Attend MSRPAC's volunteer general informational session
2. Shadow for one shift in the position
3. Interview with the Volunteer Services department representative

TIME AND PLACE:

Shifts available Tuesday thru Friday.

COMMITMENT:

Minimum of three hours per week for six months

SUPERVISION:

Direct supervision by the SNC staff. Indirect supervision by the Volunteer Services manager or coordinator.
