

VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION PROGRAMS & SERVICES

TITLE:

Helping Paws Volunteer PS-HPPP

MAJOR OBJECTIVE:

To provide pet visits to the patients at assisted living homes and rehab centers. Touching an animal has been shown to lower blood pressure, to have a soothing effect on humans and to lift patients' mood – and center residents get time away from the shelter environment!

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Visit partner facilities with a staff-approved dog (or certified staff/ volunteer- owned dog) and give patients the opportunity to meet and interact with the dog.
- 2. Handle the dog in a responsible, attentive manner.
- 3. Share information about the dog's breed, age etc. and about the center's cause.
- 4. Remove the dog from the situation if it shows signs of distress or aggression.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Comfort working with dogs
- 2. Comfort working around our older, wiser elders
- 3. Dedication to the center's philosophies
- 4. Provide own transportation and a valid driver's license
- 5. Proof of vehicle Insurance policy with \$50,000/\$100,000/\$300,000 coverage.
- 6. Minimum 18 years of age

TRAINING:

- 1. Attend MSRPAC's volunteer general informational session and round robin dog socialization session
- 2. Minimum of 15 hours dog walking experience in the dog walking program
- 3. Two shadowing sessions with a qualified volunteer
- 4. Interview with Volunteer Services Manager or designee

TIME AND PLACE:

Shifts available throughout the week

COMMITMENT:

One Helping Paws excursion per month for six months

SUPERVISION:

Direct supervision by the Volunteer Services manager or coordinator.
